Local news organizations hold those in power accountable. The “watchdog” function of objective, local reporting keeps residents aware of and engaged in government actions. According to the Brookings Institution, local news organizations keep municipal borrowing costs low and save taxpayers money by staying alert to incidences of fraud and corruption that may otherwise go unreported.

Whether in print or online, people are more likely to trust local news outlets. As you look to connect with your community through news or advertising, local news offers a trusted, effective introduction.



The Public's Right to Know



Transparency allows the public to meaningfully engage with government.

Public Notice

Governments are statutorily required to publish notices of various official actions. Requiring independent, third-party newspapers to ensure that public notices run in accordance with the law helps prevent government officials from hiding information they would prefer the public not to see. These proactively published notices mean that the public does not need to know what to request to stay informed.

Open Meetings

The public has a right to access the internal workings of government at all levels and to provide input into the political process. Open Meetings laws require public bodies to provide the public – and news organizations – notice of meeting dates as well as agendas and minutes of the meetings. Individuals should be able to learn about pending government actions and provide feedback through open meetings.

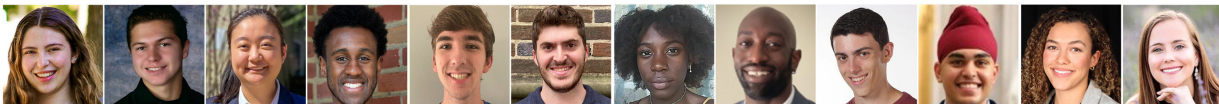
Public Records

Meaningful access to government records is critical to government transparency and a cornerstone of democracy. The public has a right to understand the government actions taken on behalf of the community. Access is central to evaluating government operations and holding leaders accountable. Public records are the primary sources for government actions and must be accessible to the public.
